Dear Parent / Carer,

I am pleased to be able to invite Year 12 students back into school for some face to face learning from next week. From 15th June the government guidance states that we are able to offer face to face support for some Year 12 students. The purpose of this is to supplement the remote education of Year 12 pupils with '*a clear expectation that remote education will continue to be the predominant form of education delivery*'. **We will therefore be inviting Year 12 students into school to follow their morning timetable from 15th June. Lessons begin at 9.30am.** Additional CEIAG and pastoral support will also be timetabled on Fridays.

Following the successful training sessions to support students continued online learning, Year 12 have accessed online live lessons this week in all their subjects. In addition, tasks continue to be set on our school website for all students <https://www.stmca.org.uk/key-information/closure-guidance/>. The face-to-face lessons in school will add to this provision to ensure that all learners are supported to make rapid progress as they approach this crucial academic year.

Student will enter school via the music entrance from 9.20am where they will sign in and use hand sanitiser. They will then enter the allocated classroom. All students will be sat at least two meters apart. **Students will need to bring any snacks and drinks with them** as the kitchen area will at this time remain closed.

All students must bring at least a pen, pencil, calculator, set of headphones and paper with them as equipment cannot be loaned at this time. It is essential that students follow social distancing at all times; this includes on their way to and from school. All are recommended by the government to avoid public transport where possible. Please do discuss with your son/daughter before next week the importance of regular hand washing, keeping two metres from others and behaving sensibly.
