Dear Parent / Carer,

Following changes to government guidance I am pleased to be able to invite Year 11 students back in to school for optional sixth form face to face taster sessions. These will take during place the week beginning 6th July and will provide students with an opportunity to try some post 16 lessons. These sessions are an addition to the transition material provided on the website <https://www.stmca.org.uk/key-information/key-information-for-year-11-and-13/>.

Sessions begin at 13.00pm and will last for one hour. Students will enter school via the music entrance from 12.50pm where they will sign in and use hand sanitiser. They will then enter the allocated classroom. All students will be sat at least two meters apart. Should the number of students exceed the classroom capacity a second session will be delivered 14.00 – 15.00. Students will be able to wait in the sixth form centre at a distance.

Please note that these sessions include the addition of Core Mathematics, this is a level 3 qualification designed to help students who want to further their mathematics education by applying knowledge to realistic contexts. As well as LIBF. This is a Level 3 Diploma in Financial Education which is an A Level equivalent qualification from The London Institute of Banking & Finance. This vocational qualification serves as a strong grounding for undergraduate study within finance and business-related disciplines, with many students going on to study accounting, business, finance and banking.

All students are asked to bring at least a pen and pencil with them as equipment cannot be loaned at this time. It is essential that students follow social distancing at all times; this includes on their way to and from school. All are recommended by the government to avoid public transport where possible. Please do discuss with your son/daughter before next week the importance of regular hand washing, keeping two metres from others and behaving sensibly.
