Supporting with Revision

Revision is vital for all students but it can lead to a great deal of stress and anxiety. We've included some tips below for parents:

- Encourage your child to start revision early.
- Encourage your child to be organised and use the revision timetable we provide. Space out the different topics they study.
- Encourage your child to use Seneca, our online homework, where there are lots of useful revision questions. Usernames and passwords are the same as logging into a school computer.
- Encourage your child to purchase revision guides (£6 Parent Pay) or revision cards (£10 Parent Pay) from school.
- Ask your child if you can help them: checking their knowledge, chatting to them over meals, using flashcards to quiz them.
- Encourage your child to attend revision sessions and complete all their homework.
